Purpose:

Provide setup and operation of sound, lights, and/or video equipment during worship and special events. We strive to serve God by creating unique and relevant worship experiences.

Duties:

Audio – Adjusting microphone levels for pastors, instrumentalists, and vocalists

Slides – Advance the worship service slides and play video clips during worship services

Live Stream – Operate the sanctuary cameras during worship services and special events to reach those who are unable to attend.

Lighting – Operate the Life Center lights during services to create an impactful worship service.

Time required:

Traditional Worship 8:30 am – 15 minutes prior to a service, one hour during a service

Contemporary – Pre-service 9:45am-10am. Service 10am-11:15am

Other special services (Christmas, Easter, etc) as needed

Length of commitment:

Quarterly schedules accommodate individual availabilities and are sent to each crew member.

Substitutes can be arranged through the worship technical director when needed.

Skills and qualifications needed: Audio/Video/Lighting Technology

- Basic computer literacy.
- A desire to learn and be part of a team that creates unique and relevant worship experiences.
- Must be able to fulfill commitments to scheduled services or events, or arrange for a substitute.
- Commitment to at least one weekend service every month
- Students under 18 must have parental approval to participate

Training provided:

Basic training will be provided for all positions as needed. More advanced training is available for those who have interest and time.
