

Greeters for Sacred Worship Service

Purpose: The purpose of this ministry is simple: To meet and greet members and visitors to our Sacred Worship church services. Greeters are our “front door,” providing a warm welcome and directions as people arrive for worship.



Responsible to: The ministry coordinator is Jacquie Korff, who serves as contact person for this ministry. The St. Peter church staff person providing direction is Jonathan Frohn.

Job Description:

- **Greeters** arrive 15 to 20 minutes prior to the worship service. They share a smile and “glad to see you” greeting with people as they arrive, providing directions and assistance as needed.
- **The greeter coordinator** maintains the ministry roster and welcomes and trains new volunteers. The coordinator serves as the contact person and, in general, seeks the good of the ministry! When more greeters are desired, they partner with Karen Kogler in the recruitment process.

Time Required: Greeters are scheduled through ‘Planning Center Online’, our online scheduling tool. Greeters serve for a month at a time [4 or 5 Sundays]. The Greeter Coordinator serves an additional 1 to 2 hours per month when needed as a substitute.

Length of commitment: It’s helpful if you serve at least one year. You are on the schedule until you let us know you wish to be removed. Request for a substitute- call Jacquie Korff.

Training provided: One of our current volunteers would be happy to greet with you the first time.

Qualifications or special skills: A smile and a desire to welcome worshipers to our church.

Benefits to the volunteer: This is happy work, and a nice way for parents and children to serve together. You’ll often meet new people and reconnect with friends.
