Adult Choir (Voices of Worship)

Time required: Rehearsals are 6:30-7:30pm on Thursdays.

Length of commitment: One season (September-May), or a partial season, with renewals as desired.

Training provided: Choral training is a part of every rehearsal, and members learn proper singing technique as they learn their songs. Regular attendance helps the entire group sing with more confidence and clarity.

Qualifications: All adult members (ages high school and up) are welcome! Choir members need to be able to sing, but formal music reading is not a prerequisite. Commitment to consistent attendance at rehearsals and worship is a high value.
