Brass Choir (Alleluia Brass)

Purpose: The Brass Choir provides music for worship regularly to give glory to God and edify the congregation during hymn singing and as special musical offerings.

Responsible to: The organist. Eric Nelson is the ministry coordinator (Director of the Brass Choir.)

Job description: The Brass Choir provides music for worship about one Sunday per month, generally at the early Traditional service on Sunday. The Choir also performs at some off-campus events.



Time required: Rehearsals are 7:00-8:30 pm Thursdays year-round, although seasonal participation is fine. We play for worship once per month plus 3-4 special events per year, some off-campus.

Length of commitment: One season (September- May, or a partial season), with renewals as desired.

Training provided: Training is limited to part instruction and musical interpretation during rehearsal.

Qualifications: A high school instrumental music background (or equivalent) and intermediate music reading skills are a prerequisite. A basic understanding of your instrument is assumed. Commitment to consistent attendance at rehearsals and worship is very important.

If you are interested, contact Eric Nelson to arrange an orientation for you to answer any questions you have. He will arrange for you to participate in a rehearsal if desired.
