Lutheran Laymen's League Ministry

Purpose: The LLL is a men's fellowship organization organized to offer Christian fellowship opportunities for the men of the congregation, with monthly meetings and various service events. This contributes to our church mission of leading people to a full life in Christ by helping them to better know each other in Christian fellowship and to serve the Lord.

The LLL motto is: "Serving Christ and His people". Through the LLL, our members are built up in Christ, the church is strengthened and God's kingdom is furthered.



Responsible to and supported by: Senior Pastor and supporting Lead Staff. The ministry is coordinated by Mike Bertermann.

Job duties:

Regular LLL members

- Attend monthly meetings 4th Tuesday of each month (typically 2-3 hours per meeting) includes light meal, entertainment, business meeting and/or guest speaker
- Several opportunities to serve at various LLL events (Turkey Dinner, Church Picnic, Live Nativity, etc.) and other church/ school projects. Time is variable, but can be 1-5 hours per event.
- Must be male members of St. Peter and 18 years of age and older.

LLL Leadership (Executive Board)

- Several positions (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, various committee chairs)
- Organize monthly meetings (location, food, guest speaker)
- Attend Board meeting 2nd Tuesday of each month (~1-2 hours)

Time required: Combined with previous section

Length of commitment: Individuals may remain members if they continue to be members of St. Peter Lutheran Church. Leadership positions serve two year terms (up to two terms consecutively).

Training: Not a lot of training is needed. Any necessary training can be "on-the-job".

Skills/qualifications: People in leadership positions should have good planning, organization and communications skills. They should enjoy leading men in conducting the LLL projects.

Benefit to the volunteer: Members experience Christian fellowship in a relaxed and friendly environment. One can also get satisfaction from serving other members of St. Peter in a variety of settings.
