Small Group Leaders

Purpose: The purpose of small group leaders is to create relationships with middle school youth and facilitate conversation among their peers.

Responsible to: Steven Heick, Leader of youth discipleship

Job description: The Middle School ministry meets on Sunday mornings from 10 - 11am. After an activity and a large group lesson, students break off into small group discussion. Volunteer Leaders and Co-Leaders encourage conversation and create relationships with students in these small groups. Discussion guides are provided.

Time requirement: Weekly on Sunday mornings 10-11 am. Additionally, a short monthly leader training meeting is held. In addition to Sunday mornings, there are occasional large events. Small Group leaders also check in with students outside of Sunday mornings (usually once a month).

Length of commitment: Ideally, volunteers commit to an entire year.

Training provided: Training is provided through weekly email and monthly volunteer gatherings.

Skills/Qualifications: Volunteers should be passionate about youth, highly relational, and able to manage a small group of middle school students. Youth Ministry Volunteers must be protection screened.

Benefits to volunteer: Volunteers will find fulfillment and spiritual growth through leadership.
