Responsible to and supported by: This ministry is directed by the Teaching Pastor, Rev. Dr. Randy Rozelle. The ministry coordinator is Debra Sommerfeld.



Job duties:

Weekly Prayer Chain:

- a. The prayer chain coordinator receives prayer requests from multiple sources, including church staff, congregation prayer cards, direct submission to the point people and through the prayer section of the Spiritual Care Team Page.
- b. Edit the prayer requests and makes them available to the Prayer Team members .
- c. Prayer Team members are encouraged to pray for individuals requesting prayer support during their personal prayer time.

Length of commitment: For most positions, a one-year commitment is requested.

Training: Minimal training is needed for group volunteers. One needs only to read through the prayer requests that have been submitted.

Skills and qualifications: For coordinators, good organization and communication skills are needed. For all others, the only qualification needed is a heart to spend quiet time with Jesus, interceding for others.

Benefits to the volunteer: The volunteer's own prayer time will be blessed greatly. The time in prayer is filled with blessings including a greater appreciation of God's great love and mercy and a deepening of one's own walk with Jesus.
